

TO: Governor Mike Huckabee  
State of Arkansas

This is intended as follow-up to our earlier notice sent to you regarding our Declaration of Citizens' Rights to Keep and Bear Arms within the Borders of the Sovereign State of Arkansas. It was sent to you in October of 1998 by Registered Mail. It included, among other things, THE RIGHT TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS, Report of The SUBCOMMITTEE ON THE CONSTITUTION, OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE JUDICIARY, UNITED STATES SENATE, NINETY-SEVENTH CONGRESS second session, February 1982, Orin Hatch, Chairman; a copy of the hand book of The Militia of Washington County, Arkansas; and a book, entitled "The Second Amendment Primer" by Adams.

Your failure to object to that Declaration provides affirmation that, in your capacity as head of this sovereign state, you have no objection to it.

This Declaration is now registered with the Secretary of State, the Honorable Sharon Priest, of the State of Arkansas as an apostilled document No. 991156, presentable as factual evidence in any Court in this State or the United States. And recorded on October 19, 1998, in Bk 3, Pg 255/270, Washington County Circuit Clerk Office.

In order to fulfill its Constitutional duty to provide security to this free state, The Militia of Washington County Arkansas does now present this Public Notice, DECLARATION of CITIZENS RIGHT TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS WITHIN THE SOVEREIGN STATE OF ARKANSAS to peaceably uphold the "right" of Arkansas Citizens "to keep and bear arms for their common defense", and to provide for the arming of Volunteer Militia "companies of infantry, cavalry or artillery", as authorized by Article 11, section 2, of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas.


#### NOTICE

#### DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY THE BUREAU OF ALCOHOL TOBACCO AND FIREARMS

We, The Militia of Washington County Arkansas, do find, and do now herewith, formally, and publicly, Notice the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms ("BATF") that the said Militia and other Militia or Law enforcement of the Great and Honorable State of Arkansas, are not commercial or taxable agencies, neither are the aforesaid Militia or Law enforcement under the jurisdiction of the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms, nor are we required to pay tax or tribute on "firearms", and have no authority to interact in any capacity with the "BATF" or any other foreign agency. The Constitution, the Legislative body, and the Governor of the State of Arkansas are the Authority for the Militia in the sovereign State of Arkansas. We now consider this matter forever closed, sealed, and settled. The Facts presented in this DECLARATION of CITIZENS RIGHTS TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS WITHIN THE SOVERIEGN STATE OF ARKANSAS, and the supporting documented facts are the final authority on this matter, and shall be considered factual rebuttal to the presumption left standing in the case of U.S. v. Miller, 307U.S.174(1939), and to any further presumptions that may hereafter arise.
